

Computing – The children will start off learning about how to stay safe online before learning about programming. They will use the BeeBots to enter algorithms to make them follow different instructions.

Reading - The children will be supported to work on their predicting, inference, fluency and comprehension questions during class. As well as using their phonic knowledge to read new words.
A lot of our learning in English will be based around some of the traditional tales. Regular reading is paramount to the children's learning.

PSHE – The children will be able to recognise discrimination and how to appreciate everyone's values. As well as learning about different emotions, what they look/feel like and how we can express how we feel.

Religious Education - The children will learn about how should we care for others and the world and why does it matter.

English - Our lessons will be based around seaside fiction and non-fiction books such as Sally and The Limpet. The children will write fact files about different animals and key features of post cards and letters. As always, we will focus on the correct use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

Maths – We will be looking at the place value of numbers to 100. Counting in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s and finding a half and quarter of objects. Later on, in the term we will continue to develop our understanding of days, months and years and work towards telling the time by the hour and half hour.

Science – The children will be learning about different animals and animal groups. What similarities and differences they have and where they live. As well as types of different plants and their features. This term's topic lends itself nicely to plenty of learning about how to look after our planet.

PE – The children will be focusing fundamental movement skills through Athletic focused activities.

Geography – The children will learn about key features of different settings, such as harbours and cliffs. As well as learning about different physical and human features in the environment. Key places such as harbour etc. etc.
