Computing -

We will be using TinkerCad to develop our 3D modelling skills.

Reading -

Our reading for pleasure book this term is Impossible Creatures by Katherine Rundell.

PSHE -

We will be looking into the risks involved within various contexts and the consequences of risk taking. We will also have an introduction to basic first aid.

Religious Education -

This term we will be answering the question 'What kind of king is Jesus?' To do this we will make connections between the Kingdom of God and how Christians put their beliefs into practice in various ways.

English -

Our main focus is narrative writing. We will be using the book Viking Boy as a stimulus for our writing. We will be recapping and using the writing skills we have learnt throughout the year to up-level and improve our final piece. We will also complete a variety of smaller pieces of writing.

We will learn how to perform long division and look into Roman Numerals. Once we have finished these areas of learning, we will recap the maths curriculum so that we are prepared for the SATs in May.

Science –
