Year 2 In maths this week we have been counting money in pence. We have used our previous knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and our knowledge of adding tens and ones to help us do this.

In history we have looked at Motte and Bailey castles and have labelled their features.

Year 3 What a wonderful start to our term! We have finished our information writing about Earthquakes, including some top tips to keep safe. We also looked at the devastation that tsunamis can cause by looking at some photographs of the aftermath of the wave that hit Japan in 2011.

In French, we have been learning the names of different items of clothing and asking each other "Qu'est-ce qu'il y a dans l'armoire?"- What is in the wardrobe?

We have had a lovely first week after half term in **Reception** Class and the children have come back ready to learn and play! This week we have been reading the story of 'Mr Gumpy's Outing'; we have enjoyed acting out the story, describing the main character, mapping out the story and drawing characters from the story using oil pastels.



Year 1 have enjoyed working scientifically this week during our Floating or Sinking topic.

They made predictions about which objects would float or sink. They loved carrying out short investigations to see whether their predictions were right.

They certainly showed their delight when they were

correct! Great fun! Great learning! Some announced that they wanted to be a Scientist when they grow up Awe-

some!



Year 4 In English this week, we have looked at poetry features, especially personification and similes, ready to include in our own poems next week. In geography, we used our knowledge of physical features to compare Gloucester with Manaus, a town in the Amazon Rainforest. In RE this week we reminded ourselves of Holy Week and will be looking at the important days in this week in coming lessons.

This week **Year 5** have been diving headfirst into their chapter book: 'Pig Heart Boy'. The class have been predicting the end of the book, which is full of twists and unpredictable turns!
