### 5. Fundraising focus 2022/2023

Liz spoke to the teachers just after their meeting at the beginning of term. The following two topics were discussed:

- Mrs Woodland is doing Forest School Training. School would like outdoor equipment for Forest School.
  - School to provide a list of equipment that would be required.
  - Charlotte W, has forest school experience, to speak to Mrs Woodland about her requirements.
- Miss Bussey would like markings on the playground outside the new extension
  - o 100 square grid
  - Miss Bussey to get a quote and bring proposal to FoNS

No other funds were requested for this year. It was discussed that Mr Spencer had previously requested new goal posts as the current ones are broken and potentially dangerous. Also matching t-shirts for the sports teams had previously been discussed. FoNS are awaiting a formal request with a quotation from Mr Spencer so that this can be funded.

# 6. Autumn/Winter event planning & fundraising ideas

The Village Hall remains unavailable to use due to structural issues with the roof. The first Structural Engineer who came to assess the building didn't provide a suitable service and the Village Hall Committee weren't impressed. Since then, County LEA have got involved as the lack of hall is impacting the school. Another Structural Engineer is due to assess the hall but hasn't visited yet. When the assessment is carried out, school have made it clear that they want to know what the interim plans are, how quickly the hall can be made available and the long term plan.

Gary Edgecombe wants to have a big blow-out Christmas Fayre in the village hall as soon as it's open, to include the Rugby Club, Parish Council and FoNS.

<u>Winter Fayre</u> – discussed holding a Winter Fayre event in school, just in case the village hall isn't available. Santa's Grotto can be set up in one of the classrooms, stalls/games can be in another, with refreshments available too. Plan for end of November – date TBC.

### Cake Stall at Coombe Hill Farm Shop - Saturday 1st October (9am-2pm)

Joanne Robson has asked if FoNS would like to hold a cake sale at Coombe Hill FS as The Baking Bird is unavailable that weekend. Agreed that we should do it.
