

English –

Phonics- this half term we will learn the final couple of phonemes and then the rest of the lessons will be on 'mastery', which allows the children time to apply the taught phonemes and common exception words to reading and writing with increasing confidence and accuracy.

In our English lessons we will be reading 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' and then retelling it writing short sentences for each part of the story.

Using Spring time as a stimulus the children will be writing their own Spring poem using their senses.

Mathematics –

This term in Maths we will be finding and representing 6, 7 and 8, as well as working out the composition of these numbers. We will then be finding one more and one less with numbers to 8.

The children will also be finding and making doubles to 8. As well as making pairs (odd and even)

We will be exploring measurement for length, height and time.

This is all done through hands on activities and visual representations.
