We will be looking at different types of questions and sorting items into groups based on attributes. Then using software, we will create a quiz that will sort our chosen items.

PSHE – Being my Best

We start off the term looking at a healthy balanced diet, then how to take of ourselves when we are poorly. Then we move into identifying our talents.
