

Computing –

This term year five will be developing their knowledge of **flat file databases** and **programming skills**.

Reading –

This term we will be reading '**Floodland**' by Marcus Sedgwick and '**The nowhere emporium**' by Ross MacKenzie.

French-

This term Year 5 will be learn:

- How to describe their family.

Art/Design -

We will be looking at the style of **Trompe L'oeil** from 1874, comparing it to artwork today.

This term we will be focussing on:

Science –

This term Year 5 will be learning about **reproduction of a plant and animal** and also **reversible and irreversible changes**.

Humanities –

This term Year 5 will visit **Tewkesbury**, to take part in a flooding workshop, comparing the town to 2007 and interview local residents.

We will also learn **how rivers are formed**, the impact of **flooding** and the main rivers in the UK.

Later in the term, we will identify the **key features of a mountain range**, comparing the land in Switzerland to the UK.
