Matthew's gospel, chapter 5

Year 1 The children have been amazing scientists recently. They are showing great enthusiasm during our recent exploration of rocks. They have been on a rock hunt, used lenses to observe different rocks and found that they can place rocks into more than one category. Year 3 In Design Technology (DT) we have been practicing our line drawing techniques in preparation for making prints after half term. We have begun to look at how to show movement and stillness by choosing how we draw our lines.
